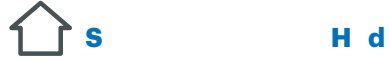

An example of how this works:

Colombo Hall has 80 rooms, so the first 80 students to accept their accommodation offer and pay the deposit will be roomed in Colombo. Any students that accept and pay after that will be placed on the waitlist for Colombo and be contacted by the Accommodation Team to discuss their hall placement.
